Read Romans 10:17

Engaging Kids:

Activity: Have kids do trust falls with parent standing behind. Kids close eyes and can only confirm parent is there by asking and hearing their voice. If they feel confident have them fall back into arms of parent.

- Was that game scary? What made it scary? If you did the trust fall, what gave you faith to do it?
- Hearing from God can give us faith that he's really there. What are some ways we can hear from God?
- Why might reading the Bible be a good way to hear from God?
- What can we do if we don't understand what it says?
- Have you ever felt like God said something to you?



Personal Reflection or Small Group Discussion:

1. What is one thing you felt God was speaking to you through the sermon this week?
2. Read Romans 10:17. What is it that stirs faith in our hearts?
3. How can the Bible be a useful tool when our faith is struggling to stir that faith again? Why does it work so well to do this?
4. What are some of the ways you have experienced God speak to you in your life?
5. Why would the Bible be an effective way for you to hear from God?
6. Can you think of a time when God particularly spoke to you through the Bible? If comfortable, share that story.
7. Over the course of the Amplified series, thus far, is there anything you've been hearing God say to you through his Word? Can you share that Scripture and perhaps pray together about the things God is saying?
8. Think of three people in your life who you feel particularly compelled to personally reach with the gospel and pray Romans 10:14-15 that God would open opportunities for you to share the message with them.
