Youth Live Chat Discussion Questions June 7 - Luke 8

Welcome (5 min)

- Say hello to each young person as they come online.
- Ask a few directed questions and try to chat with the kids as much as you're able.

Warm Up Game - True Facts (10 min)

This is simple simple! Everyone privately messages the host a secret fact about themselves, and then the host shares them one by one. Everyone then has to vote who they think it belongs to. See if your students can fool the others! You can award a point to the student who guesses correctly. And if a student is able to fool everyone then they win a point.

You can let the kids know that points will add up throughout the chat and the person at the end with the most points will win a sweet that I'll send out to them in the post.

Discussion (20 min)

(Based off of Alex's talk from Luke 8 in the Sunday Connection video. Let them know that points can be had for correct answers to questions throughout this section, which can be added to their total for winning.)

- 1. Offer 1 point to anyone (everyone) who can say one thing they remember from Alex's talk. They can't repeat what someone else has already said.
- 2. What did you think about Alex's story about Mo and the dog?
- 3. Take a look together at Luke 8:11-15. For each type of soil discuss together the type of person/situation would be an example of what Jesus is describing.
- 4. How can you know what kind of soil you are? How do you think you respond to God's word in your life right now? Do you think you respond more like Mo or the dog when God says something to you?
- 5. What could you do to learn to be more like Mo and less like the dog?

Closing Game - 5 Senses Scavenger Hunt (10-15min)

Do a home scavenger hunt as this is hugely popular with all the kids. Before your meeting write a list of items that might commonly be found in the home. Wherever they are right now is their 'base' - this is where the items in the scavenger hunt have to be brought back to (so those using mobile platforms can't take their camera to the item.

They need to leave their camera where it is and bring the item to the screen). Read out the items in turn. First person to bring the item to the screen wins a point.

This list has things that could be found in the back garden so they may need to run outside to complete.

Here's a Suggested List of Items for this week if you'd like to use it:

- Find something that makes a crunch sound
- Find something that tastes sour
- Find something that smells good
- Find something smooth
- Find 3 of the same thing
- Find something that smells bad
- Find something that tastes sweet
