### **Summary**

Alex looked at two things the disciples saw and experienced in Jesus' prayer life that made them say "teach us how to pray like that".

- That Jesus knew that God was both his Father was the King. That he both listened (as a loving parent) and would act (as a universal thing).
- That prayer is somehow like universes being created and worlds redeemed.

### **Question to help discussion**

1. Have another look at Luke 11:1-2. Treat it more than just an introduction to the Lord's Prayer but as containing teaching itself. What do you learn from it about prayer? How did Alex's explanation of these verses help you see the value of prayer?
2. What is your automatic default when it comes to God - to think he is a loving Father; or a Sovereign King? How can you cultivate a better sense of his love and listening? How can you cultivate a better sense of his power and majesty?
3. Thinking back to Genesis 2 how does it make you feel to realise that prayer is like worlds being created.
4. Thinking back to John 19:30 how does it make you feel to realise that prayer is like worlds being redeemed.
5. What place does this encourage prayer to have in your own life?
6. What has God placed on your heart to see created? What is God calling you to redeem? How will you set about praying for them?
