

## Youth Live Chat Discussion Questions September 20 - Luke 23

### Welcome (5 min)

- Say hello to each young person as they come online.
- Ask a few directed questions and try to chat with the kids as much as you're able.

### Warm Up Game - Mystery Guest (10 min)

Invite someone who your group all know but wouldn't normally attend to join your call.

Let the mystery guest in the meeting before anyone else, and have them keep their video off so their identity isn't revealed. Be sure the mystery guest changes their display name under their video feed. Let students ask one Yes or No question each, until someone figures out who it is. The person who can guess who it is will win a point.

You can let the kids know that points will add up throughout the chat and the person at the end with the most points will win a sweet that I'll send out to them in the post.

### Discussion (20 min)

(Based off of Alex's talk from Luke 23 in the Sunday Connection video. Let them know that points can be had for correct answers to questions throughout this section, which can be added to their total for winning.)

1. Offer 1 point to anyone (everyone) who can say one thing they remember from Alex's talk. They can't repeat what someone else has already said.
2. Can you remember the story Alex told near the end of the video about how the Bible represented a book about your life? Try to retell the story he told.
3. Do you have any pages in your story that you wouldn't want anyone to read or know about? Do you think Alex was right that there would be some pages that someone might die to keep people from seeing? Do you think it matters how many good or bad pages you have? Do you think that would change what Jesus did for us?
4. What did you like most about that story? Was there anything you didn't like?
5. What did Alex say a person could do if they wanted to accept Jesus' offer to take their story for his? *He said we need to **Admit** - that we have those dark pages in our lives. **Believe** - and trust in Jesus' death and then **Commit** - to follow Jesus as best you can.*
6. Close your discussion by offering to pray for everyone and perhaps ask if anyone would be courageous enough to admit they'd never accepted Jesus' offer for themselves but they think they would like to. You can tell them you'll just pray for

them now. Then you'll want to make note so you can contact them in the week to chat more. You can let Chrissy know and she can help you with getting in touch and/or with what to say if you need help.

### **Closing Game - Mini-Quiz (10-15min)**

You could close out the session with a mini-quiz. Just type in pub quiz questions or kids quiz on google and you can find loads of questions and categories. You could choose 2 categories with 6-10 questions in each.

Have each student take a piece of paper and write A, B, C, D on it and to answer they must hold up the appropriate letter. Correct answers gain a point.

### **After**

Message Chrissy to let her know who won the game (if it's a tie I'll send sweets to 2 kids).
