

LUKE 24

Read either before your small group or all together at the start.

- 1. Luke gives us a glimpse into how Peter's story ends. To find out more about Peter's conversation with Jesus you could read John 21. What do you think of Peter's journey with Jesus over these few chapters? How does it make you feel about your own mistakes? What does it teach you about your relationship with Jesus?
- 2. Read Luke 24:13-32. Have you ever had an experience like the men in the story where you heard a truth about Jesus or read something in the Bible and felt like your "heart was burning within you"? Have you had a moment like that recently? What has God been saying to you? How did you/have you/will you respond?
- 3. Chrissy said that everyone who chooses to follow Jesus will also be sent by Jesus to be his witness. How does that make you feel?
- 4. In v. 49, Jesus tells the disciples to stay in the city until the Holy Spirit comes to give them power and to help them. Which category do you fall into: hard to wait because you're ready to jump in or hard to stay because you want to run away? How could the Holy Spirit help you in either situation?
- 5. Chrissy talked about some of the ways the good news of Jesus transformed the lives of his first disciples. What is one way you would say Jesus has changed your life? (big or small!)
- 6. How can the Gospel bring clarity to what is important in our lives? What would it look like to allow your life to be shaped by that sort of Gospel clarity that the disciples had? Does it just sound too outlandish or could you see small ways where that could be possible in your life?
- 7. Why not close the group by taking time to each pray for someone you know that you'd like to come to know Jesus? You might always want to pray for each other to have boldness to be a witness for Jesus.
