Smile boxes are small boxes that contain gifts to encourage the recipient. Volunteers will be providing the contents of the boxes and they will be delivered to people's homes.

			<ul> <li>sanitise their hands before and after receiving the items and placing them in the boxes</li> <li>Before delivery finished boxes should be quarantined for 3 days</li> <li>When delivering the boxes to homes the person delivering the boxes should knock on the door, place the package in front of the front door and then step back to a distance of at least 2m</li> <li>If the person delivering the boxes finds themselves in a confined space such as in a stairwell or delivering to a door where it is not possible to maintain 2m social distancing then a face mask must be worn</li> <li>The person delivering the boxes must also be free of Coronavirus symptoms and not self isolating</li> <li>The person delivering the boxes must wash or sanitise their hands before and after each delivery</li> </ul>	М	Ν
Adverse reactions to food items provided	Box recipients	* Homemade or bought items contain allergens or that incorrect storage or handling result in food poisoning	<ul> <li>Only food items that do not need refrigeration should be included in the boxes</li> <li>If homemade items are included the volunteer making them is following good hygiene such as hand washing, clean preparation surfaces and equipment and food is only prepared by adults who are without Coronavirus symptoms and not self isolating</li> <li>All homemade food items should be labelled, include storage instructions and an ingredients list</li> <li>Bought food items should be named, include a best before date and a list of allergens</li> </ul>	L	N

RESIDUAL RISK RATING	ACTION REQUIRED
VERY HIGH (VH) Strong likelihood of fatality / serious injury occurring	The activity must not take place at all. You must identify further controls to reduce the risk rating.
HIGH (H) Possibility of fatality/serious injury occurring	You must identify further controls to reduce the risk rating. Seek further advice, e.g. from your H&S Team
MEDIUM (M) Possibility of significant injury or over 3 day absence occurring	If it is not possible to lower risk further, you will need to consider the risk against the benefit. Monitor risk assessments at this rating more regularly and closely.
LOW (L) Possibility of minor injury only	No further action required.
